


























Natural Light from Above Makes This a Bedroom You'll Want To Wake Up In




It's All About the Light For This Galley Kitchen














If you have flat ceilings, once your skylight is set outside, your installer will construct a drywall light shaft inside. This shaft directs daylight to the room below while hiding the attic space between your ceiling and roof.

The advantage to vaulted ceilings during skylight installation is that without attic space between the roof and your home's interior, there's no need for a light shaft. So, once your skylight is installed, the work's all done.



3 Types of Installation

Deck-Mounted, Curb-Mounted, Self-Flashed

When it comes to skylights, there are three different types of installation methods. To know which installation is right for a home, a skylight installer or roofer will evaluate the home's roof pitch, roof material, ceiling type, and whether this is a replacement job or a new cut-in. But whatever the method, you're installing the same great skylight that brings in plenty of natural light and fresh air!

Deck-Mounted Skylights





Curb-Mounted Skylights

Curb-mounted skylights are the most common installation preference in low-pitch or flat-roof situations. The "curb" is a frame built mostly of two-by-fours that are attached to the roof. The skylight is then installed on top of the curb. You can imagine it as a shoebox: the curb is the box and the skylight is the top.

Self-Flashed Skylights

Self-flashed skylights differ from both deck- and curb-mounted skylights because their curb and flashing are built into the skylight. No extra flashing kit is needed. The skylight sits directly over the rough opening in the roof deck and is then sealed.

The VELUX deck- and curb-mounted product family is designated as "The No Leak Skylight." It carries a 10-year installation warranty, plus 20 years on glass seal failure, 10 years on product, and 5 years on blinds and controls.

This limited warranty does not apply to VELUX products purchased prior to January 1, 2010.

VELUX offers the choice of laminated or tempered glass skylights. Impact glass and comfortplus glass are all types of laminated glass. Comfort glass is a type of tempered glass. Laminated glass is a combination of two or more glass sheets with one or more interlayers of plastic (PVB) or resin. In case of breakage, the interlayer is designed to hold the fragments together. Tempered glass is designed to break into small, pebble-like pieces. When tempered glass breaks, pieces of glass come loose and may strike an individual.
